## Casino dealer classes starting in early June

SPRINGFIELD - The Massachusetts Casino Career Training Institute (MCCTI) is offering the opportunity for students to take the necessary training to become a casino dealer in Massachusetts.

Everyone that successfully passes two classes is guaranteed an audition with MGM. The training starts in June and graduates could be working by September. There are two options, including a weekend option. Weekdays Monday through Thursday from June 3 to July 23 from 1-4 p.m. Immediately following blackjack is the carnival games course that runs during the same time frame and ends on Aug 26.
