STCC student awarded DeMarco scholarship

A Springfield Technical Community College Architecture and Building Technology student from Holyoke is this year's 2018 John Richard DeMarco Jr. Scholarship winner.

Joan DeMarco, of Suffield, presented the \$300 scholarship to Jessica D. Perella based on her commitment to furthering her education.

Perella plans to graduate with her associate degree in May and enroll in the Sustainable Community Development program at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst. Her goal is to earn her bachelor's and then pursue a master's degree in Regional Planning at UMass.

Perella, a mother of four small children, said it was exhilarating and exciting to win the scholarship.

"I feel accomplished and proud," she said. "I feel motivated to continue, because I have a will to help people."

The scholarship money will go toward books, supplies and transportation to UMass, Perella said.
